Note: Income is defined as market income, excludes government transfers and realized capital gains.

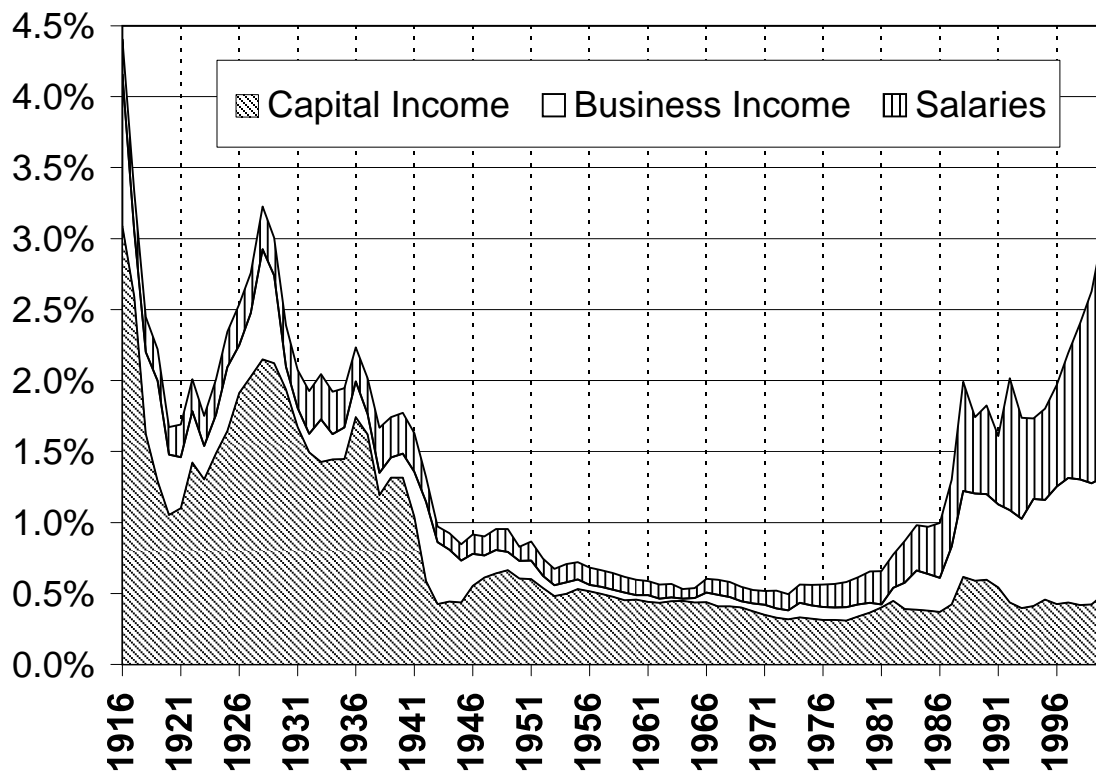


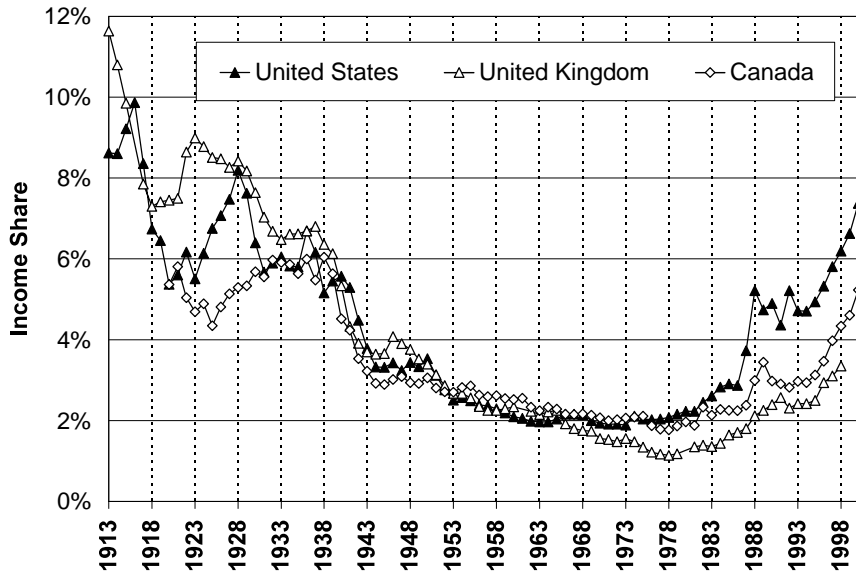

B. Top 0.1% income share in France and Japan

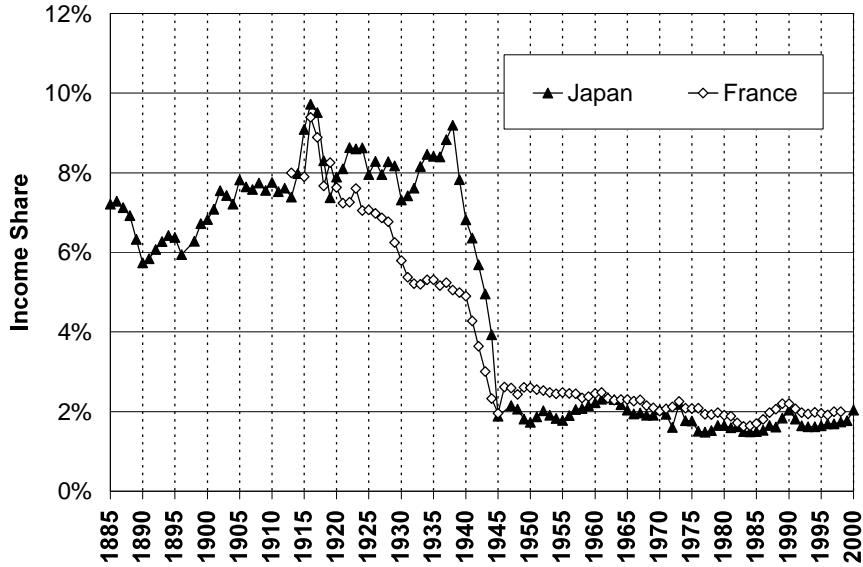

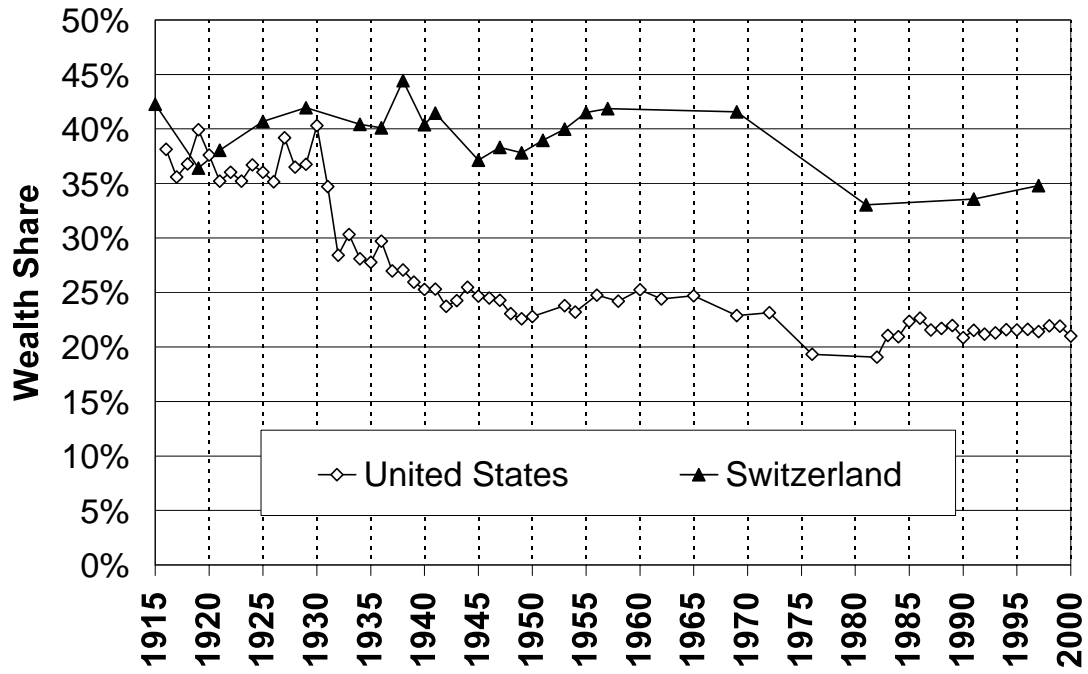
